

Supporting and Uplifting the Lim Family

Stays in 3-room HDB flat | Household income: \$1,400 per month*

Mr Lim works hard as a lift technician to take care of his family, but it has not been easy.

Mr Lim's family automatically receives GST Vouchers and Workfare. He also visited the Social Service Office (SSO) to find out how he can better provide for his family.

The SSO worked with the Lim family to understand their needs, assisted them with ComCare, and coordinated with government and community partners to provide more holistic assistance to them.

Grandma Lim, 70 years old

Recovering from stroke

- Receives \$600 Silver Support each quarter
- Receives financial assistance from the Seniors' Mobility and Enabling Fund to purchase assistive devices to support her mobility
- Receives Pioneer Generation Package
- Receives subsidised medical treatment at polyclinics and hospitals
- Attends Senior Rehabilitation and Day Care Centre

Mrs Lim, 34 years old

SSO linked Mrs Lim up with Workforce Singapore to find part-time work

Mr Lim, 35 years old

- Receives \$1,130 Workfare Income Supplement each year
- Looks forward to career progression and higher wages (under Progressive Wage Model for lift technicians)

Mr Lim's daughter, 5 years old and son, 7 years old

- Daughter receives \$150 childcare subsidy per month
- Son receives MOE Financial Assistance (covers free textbooks, school attire, and subsidised transport fares)
- Son also receives ComCare Student Care Fee Assistance of up to \$285 per month
