


Chart A: Resident households by presence of member aged 65 years and above, 2000- 2017



■ With all members aged below 65 years ■ With at least one member aged 65 years and above



Chart B: Resident households with at least 1 member aged 65 years and above, by household structure, 2000-2017





Chart C: Proportion of residents agreeing with statement "It is important for grandparents and their grandchildren to maintain close ties with each other", 2009-2016




