Outstanding Lifetime Volunteer Award

Dr Sushilan Vasoo

Dr Sushilan Vasoo has made invaluable contributions to Singapore's social service landscape over the last five decades.

Dr Vasoo's involvement with vulnerable communities started in a pioneer project in Ang Mo Kio in 1976, called the Ang Mo Kio Social Service Centre ran by three organisations, namely YMCA, Asian Welfare Women's Association and the Anglican Welfare Services. This centre was among the first examples of the voluntary sector filling the gap in services and bringing social services into the heartlands, at a time when such services were centrally located. The pioneering project was eventually replicated in many towns in Singapore as the Family Service Centres that we see today.

He was also involved in another pioneering project, the Henderson Old People's Community Home, the first Community Home for the aged which was set up in 1974 and inspired the model for future homes for the aged. This concept of community living for older persons was frequently visited by urban planners and policy makers keen on initiating ageing in place concepts. At a time when various charities were accustomed to operate and deliver services independently, Dr Vasoo advocated for partnerships and collaborations to be forged between agencies, epitomising the "many helping hands" approach which is unique to Singapore.

In 1973, Dr Vasoo led a group of volunteers to take over two nursing homes for the aged sick that were not meeting service standards. He also mobilised volunteers including students from Singapore Polytechnic and encouraged them to contribute their time and efforts in support of social welfare work in the community. He was part of the movement

that set up the first Volunteer Service Bureau in 1976, laying the foundation for development of volunteer movement in the social service sector.

Since then, Dr Vasoo has actively supported and advised many other social service agencies, including the Movement for the Intellectually Disabled of Singapore (MINDS) and Down Syndrome Association, and remain involved in the activities of these organisations to this day. He was the Vice President of the National Arthritis Foundation and Advisor to MINDS, Beyond Social Service, Ang Mo Kio Family Service Centre, Central Singapore Community Development Council and Community Care Networks.

More recently, he supported ACE Seniors, a social enterprise in Singapore to help persons aged 50+ to age successfully by launching a hotline manned by senior volunteers to support other seniors and form an ecosystem of care for this group of service users. As an honorary advisor to Ang Mo Kio GRC, he promotes the concept of active ageing for seniors to age gracefully and advocate for ageing in place. He also mobilised active seniors to befriend other seniors who are in frail health or homebound, to create a vibrant supportive community and to render preventive support for these seniors.

Volunteer Development refers to volunteer management practices that aim to foster growth, progress and positive change in volunteers. Supporting volunteers in development also equips them to better meet the agency's needs, along with improving their skills.

The Volunteer Development Guide also takes a comprehensive approach in guiding SSAs, as they are guided on how to establish and understand agency needs, as well as to keep a lens on how it will benefit volunteers in terms of increasing enjoyment, exposure, impact, flexibility and connectedness.
