
### **Regular school**

**COMMUNITY-BASED STRATEGIES** 

#### **Enhanced STEP-UP**

to engage youth with frequent absenteeism to attend school more regularly, or enrol in alternative academic, vocational or employment pathways

e.g., engagement with youth, national servicemen, educators, counsellors and parents on anti-drug messages





# **Public events**

e.g., GURD Club, DanceWorks!, DrugFreeSG Light-up event and community roadshows

#### **Advocacy building**

e.g., ground-up initiatives by youth advocates in school campuses
