COLLABORATING ON RISK-RELATED MATTERS

Collaborating effectively in risk-related situations is crucial for good outcomes because risk concerns are generally complex and may require support from multiple agencies and/or professional groups.

We can support effective collaboration by:

If supervisee is the main case holder, ensure that all stakeholders convene and keep each other up to date

Ensure that supervisee is following up with stakeholders on a regular basis

If supervisee is not the main case holder, ensure that supervisee knows who the main case holder is and knows the main tasks of each stakeholder

Jointly develop the assessment and interventions on the case

Ensure the client and all stakeholders are clear of their respective roles

Ensure that regular case conferences are held with all stakeholders involved in the care of the person

Jointly formulate intervention plans with the client and other partners involved in the case

Main stakeholders are clearly identified during the session

Stakeholders are updated regularly of key case movements and important information related to the case

Ensure that there is proper handover of cases, when the case is transferred to a different agency/worker
