Goal Setting

Social workers need to:

- build rapport with family
- engage and work with the family - arrive at mutually acceptable goals - identify an endgoal for families to

work towards



Facilitation

Social workers need to:

- help the family
- set an agenda´ engage families in assessment
- rebuild family capacity
- addrėss family power imbalance
- follow up with agenda



Intervention

Social workers need to:

- stay focused on the fámily's goals - help families
 - make decisions
- facilitate access
- to services evaluate progress regularly
 - follow up with goals
