

Debt Management





Debtor should be:

- 1) willing to seek help 2) revisit his debt management strategies 3) stick to a debt-management plan

Tips for Social Workers



Ensure debtor is not borrow<mark>ing</mark> anymore

- Make sure debtor is spending within his means
- Look at areas where debtor can cut back on expenditure





Cut interest rates

 Seek debt counselling - Help debtor re-negotiate payment without further increase in interest rate





Pay off highest debt rates first

- With the debtor, list down all debts in order of interest rates
- Focus on paying off the debt with the highest interest rate first







Negotiating payment

- Contact creditor and request for interest-free repayments
 - Search for debt consolidation loans
- Collaborate with credit counsellor to lower interest rates
