SelfReliance

ComCare Transitions

- New scheme providing assistance for those temporarily unable to work.

Grow

Centre-based Financial **Assistance Scheme for** Childcare (CFAC)/ Kindergarten Financial Assistance Scheme (KiFAS)

- Increase in subsidies for childcare by up to \$20/month.
- Eligibility criteria to include new income tier of \$1,501-\$1,800.
- Subsidies extended to nursery programmes.

EnAble

Public Assistance

- Public Assistance
 From May 2008: rates
 revised upwards.
 An elderly recipient liv
 - An elderly recipient living alone now gets \$330/month.
 - PA recipients also receive free medical treatment, subsidized rentals, utilities and service & conservancy charges rebates. They also receive help from the community such as free meals, hongbaos etc.
 - From July 2008: eligibility criteria to include those with children who are unable to support them.
