- Launched in July 2005.
- Up to 50% project funding for a maximum of 3 years, capped at \$300,000.
- 21 projects approved and \$4.1 million disbursed to date.

A Successful CSPF Project

The Bridging Programme for Pre-School Children was first piloted to provide intensive coaching to prepare disadvantaged pre-schoolers for primary school. Today, it is a national programme helmed by the Self-Help Groups (the Chinese Development Assistance Council, Eurasian Association, Singapore Indian Development Association and Yayasan MENDAKI) and funded by the Ministry of Education.

Who can apply for CSPF?
