

If we don't evaluate a programme/policy, we would not know whether it has achieved the intended outcomes.

IS EVALUATION?

- Evaluation is a process that critically examines a programme or policy.
- We evaluate to make judgments about a programme and determine effectiveness.



TO EVALUATE?

Articulate programme theory and goals Monitor and collect KPI and other indicators set up based on programme theory

Assess process and outcome against benchmark, and interpret results



SHOULD WE EVALUATE?



Help you decide whether a programme/policy has met its goals and objectives



Drive improvements



Inform resource allocation


