WHAT is fidelity monitoring?





Monitoring fidelity at the practitioner level is imperative to interpreting outcomes.

WHY monitor fidelity?



To understand the degree to which the programme is delivered according to the programme intent and specifications




To provide a measure of the progress of the implementation and improvement efforts

Experts or supervisors

"HOW"

Rate adherence and quality of **delivery** by practitioners through audio/video recordings, onsite observations/interviews

PRACTICE CHECKLIST



"OHW **Practitioners**

"HOW"

Complete checklists to track adherence/dosage (whether key intervention activities were completed)

CASE FILE REVIEW



"WHO"

Programme experts or trained staff

"HOW"

Review case documentations to track adherence/dosage (whether key intervention activities were delivered) and participant responsiveness
