Dr. Lee Tung Jean is currently Director of the Energy Division at the Ministry of Trade and Industry. She was instrumental in developing a national energy policy framework, by putting in place measures to enhance Singapore's energy objectives with regard to price competitiveness, energy security and environmental sustainability. In particular, she drove the development of the Liquefied Natural Gas terminal and the plans for future gas infrastructure and gas procurement. She also oversaw the review of regulatory frameworks for the electricity and gas markets for more robust oversight of the energy sector.

In her previous postings within the Singapore Administrative Service, she has worked on sea transport and telecommunications policies at the then-Ministry of Communications, investment and fiscal policies at the Ministry of Finance, as well as addressed Singapore's water needs and developed industry capabilities at the Ministry of the Environment and Water Resources.

Dr. Lee holds a BA (Hons) from Harvard University, an MA in Economics from Yale University, and a DPhil in Economics from Oxford University, which she pursued on a Rhodes scholarship.

Dr. Lee is married, and a mother to three children aged 14, 8 and 4.
