

REVOCATION
Regulation 21 of the Mental Capacity Regulations

NOTE TO DONOR

1. There are 3 parts to this document: Parts A, B and C.
2. You may revoke (cancel) your Lasting Power of Attorney while you have capacity to make such a Revocation. See Part A.
3. You must take reasonable steps to **give notice to every** donee that you are revoking the Lasting Power of Attorney. See Part B. If you fail to do so, they may legally continue to make decisions on your behalf in the event you should lose your capacity. You may have them sign the acknowledgement in Part B or produce other evidence to satisfy the Public Guardian that you have given them notice of the revocation.
4. You must also notify the Public Guardian of the revocation. See Part C. You may submit to the Public Guardian this Revocation document duly completed and signed together with –
 - the original Lasting Power of Attorney issued for cancellation, and
 - the cancellation of registration of a lasting power of attorney fee of \$25.
