ComCare Grow

Focuses on the developmental needs of children from needy families, to help them break out of the poverty cycle.

About **14,000 children** are receiving subsidies under ComCare Grow.

Healthy Start Programme (HSP)

Provides at-risk, low-income families with support to strengthen the family as a unit.

Centre-based Financial Assistance Scheme for Childcare (CFAC)/Kindergarten Financial Assistance Scheme (KiFAS) /Student Care Fee Assistance (SCFA)

Help working parents with subsidies for childcare/kindergarten or nursery/student care fees.

DID YOU KNOW?

The ComCare Fund budget for FY08 is **\$63.7 million**. Including other social services and social infrastructure, we expect to spend **\$168 million** to help the low-income and needy in this financial year.

ComCare SelfReliance

Helps the needy achieve self-reliance.

About **10,500 cases** are being helped through ComCare SelfReliance.

Work Support

Helps households tide over difficult periods as long as work-capable household members are committed to working towards self-reliance.

ComCare EnAble

Helps the needy who require long-term assistance to integrate into the community.

About **3,200 cases** are being helped through ComCare EnAble.

Public Assistance

Helps those who are unable to work, have no means of subsistence and no one to depend on.
