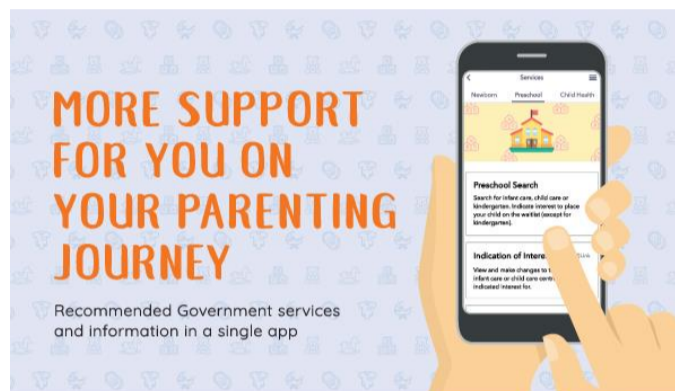




Release of Moments of Life (Families) App

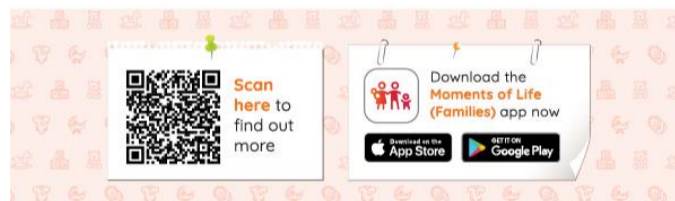

Pilot Programme to Bring New Learning Approach to Preschools

The Early Childhood Development Agency (ECDA), in collaboration with Temasek Foundation Cares, will pilot an initiative in selected preschools, which will see teachers being trained to apply teaching and learning strategies under the Abecedarian Approach (AA) in the classroom. AA is an evidence-based approach that emphasises language development and high quality adult-child interactions to stimulate child development and growth.

The three-year pilot, named the “Temasek Foundation Cares – ABCD (Abecedarian Based Child Development) Kids Programme”, aims to better support the early development of infants and toddlers from low-income families in these preschools. This will contribute to the holistic development of children in their early years, forming a strong foundation for a good start in life.

A/P Muhammad Faishal Ibrahim, Senior Parliamentary Secretary for Social and Family Development, together with Professor Joseph Sparling who developed AA, visited PCF Sparkletots preschool at Kebun Baru that has been selected to pilot the programme on 11 July.
