COVID-19 VACCINATIONS FOR STUDENT CARE CENTRE STAFF

Thank you for your participation in the COVID-19 vaccination programme and valued contributions to supporting our nation's fight against the COVID-19 pandemic.

2 The COVID-19 vaccination programme seeks to protect Singaporeans against COVID-19, as well as to protect businesses and jobs through the progressive re-opening of Singapore. Vaccination for staff in Student Care Centres has been progressively offered from 20 March 2021 onwards. Staff who have registered for vaccination would have received an SMS invitation to register for the vaccination and schedule an appointment via the National Appointment System.

3 If you or your staff have not booked a slot within the 14-day time limit¹, but are keen to be vaccinated, you may register your interest and will be notified to make an appointment when there are slots available. You can re-register by clicking on the same unique link in the original SMS notification. If you need assistance with your appointment booking, please contact MOH at 1800 333 9999.
