Press; 1975.






The brain grows fastest during our early years – it is 80% of adult size by 3 years old

Adverse childhood experiences make children vulnerable to adverse life-long effects




Figure: The life-cycle approach to developmental risk factors (reproduced from Ertem, 2011)

Objective

To give children from low-income families a good start in life



Desired outcomes

Age-appropriate child development

Improved parent-child interactions

Earlier enrolment; preschool attendance

Who qualifies for KidSTART?

Singapore Citizen children aged up to 6 years old

Low-income families GHHI<\$1,900 or PCI<\$650

Residing in the pilot regions (Taman Jurong, Boon Lay, Bukit Merah, Kreta Ayer, Geylang Serai)
