


Patience/ perseverance




- Patience & perseverance a Prophetic virtue
 - "Those inflicted with the hardest adversities are Prophets"
 - To raise one's spiritual station
- Seeks to nurture resilience in adversity
- Strengthen one's resolve to strive for betterment of circumstances

Trust in God's Plan




- Entrusting results in Allah <u>after the effort is made</u>
- Rooted in the Prophetic tradition "Tie your camel and then entrust in God's care"
- Help cope & manage anxiety, worry & fear to enable focus on the present, develop mindfulness when faced with adversity.
- Misunderstanding between non-attachment to temporal world with renouncing material needs

Contentment with God's will




- Closely related to syukr, or gratitude
- Seek to nurture contentment so as not to be distracted by too many temporal ambitions to the point of losing joy in the existing ones
- To uplift when faced with failure, disappointment & hardship

<u>Issues resulting from misunderstanding</u>




- To try hard to get out of poverty & hardship = as if not contented with fate - Constant improvement in both temporal & spiritual life is religiously demanded
- Acceptance to the point of complacency & no sense of urgency as tribulation is perceived as God's way of raising one's spiritual station
 - Family violence PROHIBITED!, duty to protect, not disobedience
 - Delay in seeking financial or social as rooted in as waiting for God's assistance against concept of tawakkal after effort
 - Issue of higher number of children in families needing assistance family planning? Blessings which comes with responsibility in parenting.

Issues resulting from misunderstanding



- Idea of the best form of sustenance is one that a person provides for his own family from their own effort
 - Worry of dishonouring family "face" or not wanting to be judged
 - Neglect of spousal duty as husband to provide for family need to
 educate on marriage being a partnership / Attain assistance in
 any permitted form to provide family's basic needs is fulfilling duty
 - Contentment with what is already bestowed = no sense of urgency
 - God has willed for one to leave in poverty Submitting is not giving up – Giving up is religious frowned upon as it is denying God's bounties upon oneself & family


Reflection Points
